

MEA plans to rope in Indian missions to hard sell rupee-denominated trade

Focus is on neighbouring countries, nations with foreign exchange shortage

New Delhi, August 3
To persuade trading partners to consider bilateral trade with India in rupees following the RBI's decision last month to allow such a mechanism, the Ministry of External Affairs is planning to write to its embassies and missions abroad. The Ministry will explain in detail how the system works, so that our ambassadors and envoys, too, can help spread the word effectively, a person tracking the matter has said. Apart from Russia and Iran, which would gain from rupee-denominated trade as it helps them get past economic sanctions imposed by the West, India's focus in the beginning is likely to be on getting on board

neighbouring countries and those with foreign exchange problems including African nations, the source added. "At present, the problem is that not many have understood how the mechanism of trade settlement in rupee will work. We will have to write to our embassies, and explain to our ambassadors how the mechanism actually operates. Then bilaterally we have to talk to countries and tell them that this is a good opportunity for both sides," the source told BusinessLine.

RBI guidelines
Per RBI guidelines, for settlement of trade transactions with any country, the authorised dealer banks in India may



open special rupee vostro accounts of correspondent banks of the partner trading country. Indian importers are to make the payment in rupees which will be credited into the special vostro account of the correspondent bank of the partner country, against the invoices for the supply of goods or services from the overseas seller.

Focus areas
Neighbouring countries such as Sri Lanka, Nepal and Bhutan could be India's priority for rupee-denominated trade as the country has a substantial economic and diplomatic influence in the region, the source said. Focus is also likely to be on

countries with forex shortage including several African nations, and when India decides to give them lines of credit, loans can be raised for them in rupee instead of dollars, the source explained. It would also serve India's interest to get countries that have a trade surplus with India to engage in rupee-denominated trade as India could then save on its foreign exchange substantially and the excess currency (rupee) that the partner country holds could be invested in India.

"Rupee settlement of international trade has to be planned strategically. All concerned Ministries and Departments, including financial services, economic affairs, commerce, agriculture and petroleum, will hopefully work on it together," the source added.

Inflation drags services PMI to 4-month low of 55.5 in July

Service recovery loses pace amid weaker sales growth

Higher prices impacted the service sector as the Purchasing Managers' Index (PMI) slipped to 55.5 in July from 59.2 in June. This is its lowest in four months. Also, jobs showed negligible growth. The manufacturing PMI had surged to an eight-month high of 56.4 in July. While manufacturing has a share of 14.4 per cent in Gross Value Added (GVA), share of services is around 55 per cent. Like manufacturing, the services PMI is prepared by S&P Global on the basis of responses from 400 service sector companies. The

sectors include consumer (excluding retail), transport, information communication, finance, insurance, real estate and business services. An index value above 50 shows expansion, while below 50 means contraction.

Key factors
A report accompanying the PMI said recovery in the service sector lost momentum in July as weaker sales growth and inflationary pressures restricted an upturn in business activity. While marketing efforts underpinned another rise in new work intakes, competitive pressures and unfavourable weather dampened demand. That said, the weaker recovery was supplemented by retreating price pressures. Input costs increased at the

slowest rate since February, while output charges were hiked to a lesser extent than in June.

Pollyanna De Lima, Economics Associate Director at S&P Global Market Intelligence, however, finds many positives in the latest results. Business activity continued to rise strongly, with a similarly robust uplift in new business as the offering of new services

and marketing efforts bore fruit. "There was, however, a noticeable loss of momentum for the Indian service economy as demand was somewhat curtailed by competitive pressures, elevated inflation and unfavourable weather," she said.

Job creation
Both output and sales increased at the weakest rates for four months. "In line with concerns that economic growth has weakened as we enter the second fiscal quarter, service providers signalled subdued confidence towards the medium-term business outlook. Only 5 per cent of panellists forecast output growth over the course of the coming 12 months, while 94 per cent predict no change from present

levels," she said. Based on the survey, the report found a negligible increase in service sector employment across India. The rate of job creation was fractional and broadly similar to June. The vast majority of firms left payroll numbers unchanged amid a lack of need to raise workforces. Indeed, "capacity pressures remained only mild, with the average level of outstanding business rising at a slight pace that was the weakest in three months," it said.

Services companies reported a further increase in their average expenses during July, with food, fuel, materials, staff, retail and transportation cited as the key sources of inflationary pressures. Input costs rose sharply, though at the slowest pace in five months.

FinMin raises windfall gain tax

The Finance Ministry has raised the windfall gain tax on the domestically produced petroleum crude, but has lowered export levies on diesel and jet fuel (aviation turbine fuel).

This is the second revision after export levies were imposed on July 1. The revision is done fortnightly and the revised levies will be effective August 3.

The increase in windfall gain tax is negative for companies such as Reliance, ONGC and Oil India.

According to notifications issued by the Central Board of Indirect Taxes & Customs (CBIC), the windfall gain tax on petroleum crude produced domestically will now be ₹17,750 as against ₹17,000 per tonne. Initially, it was ₹23,250 per tonne, which was cut to ₹17,000 per tonne on July 18. One of the reasons for raising the windfall gain tax could be the rise in crude prices.

The decision to impose the windfall gain tax followed the sharp rise in the crude prices in recent months.

Export of diesel, jet fuel

The notification said that export levies on diesel have been lowered from ₹11 per litre to ₹5 a litre, while it has been removed from ATF; it was ₹4 per litre earlier. On the export of petrol, the 'nil' duty continues.

On the export levy on diesel, the Ministry's reasoning was that with crude oil becoming costlier, prices of diesel, petrol and ATF have increased sharply.

18% GST on ice-cream parlours effective only from Oct 6, 2021

Exam entrance fee, developed land, IVF treatment not to attract GST

Ice-cream parlours can breathe easy as the Finance Ministry has said that the 18 per cent GST will not take retrospective effect. It also said that fees for entrance exams, issuance of migration certificates etc and charges for preferred location of land will not attract GST.

Based on the recommendations by the GST Council in its June meeting, the Finance Ministry came out with a set of circulars clarifying taxation issues on various goods and services, on Wednesday.

Earlier circular

Last September, the GST Council recommended levying of GST on ice-cream parlours at the rate of 18 per cent with ITC, and not 5 per cent without ITC. The argument was that since they sell already manufactured goods, they are not restaurants and so attract GST at the higher rate.

Accordingly, a circular was issued in October last year for imposition of higher rate, but there was no clarity whether it would be prospectively or retrospectively applied. This created some confusion that the higher rate could be levied from July 1, 2017.

Now, it has been clarified that the higher rate would be effective from October 6, 2021. "Since the decision is only to

regularise the past practice, no refund of GST shall be allowed, even if already paid at 18 per cent," a circular issued on Wednesday said.

Land lease, education, IVF

The same circular clarified that the amount or fee charged from prospective students for entrance or admission, or for issuance of eligibility certificate to them in the process of their entrance/admission as well as the fee charged for issuance of migration certificates by educational institutions is covered by the exemption under the GST notification.

The circular clarified that location charges or preferential location charges paid upfront in addition to the lease premium for long term lease of land constitute part of upfront amount charged for

long term lease of land and are eligible for the same tax treatment, and therefore eligible for exemption. "It is clarified that sale of developed land is also sale of land, and accordingly [it] does not attract GST," it said. However, it may be noted that any service provided for development of land, like levelling, laying of drainage lines (as may be received by developers) shall attract GST at applicable rate for such services.

On the issue of applicability of GST on services in the form of Assisted Reproductive Technology (ART) in vitro fertilisation (IVF), the circular said: "It is clarified that services by way of IVF are also covered under the definition of health care services for the purpose of exemption from notification."
